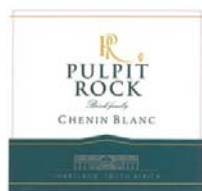
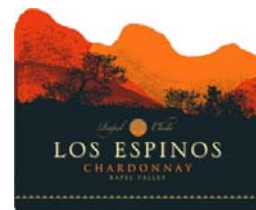

1. MUANG THAI HOUSE WHITE Chassan Chardonnay (France) <i>Chardonnay & Chassan Grapes are blended by one of Southern France's leading wineries to produce a wine full of ripe citrusy, tropical fruit, crisp acidity and a refreshing finish.</i>	3.30	11.50
2. MUANG THAI HOUSE RED Merlot Cabernet (France) <i>A classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot grapes produced in the French midi. A great climate and new world know how combine to produce a soft, fleshy, warm appealing red.</i>	3.30	11.50

IMPORTED THAI WHITE WINE Monsoon Valley (Siam Winery) <i>This wine is made from the local Malaga Blanc grape grown on the amazing "floating Vineyards" North of the gulf of Thailand in the Chao Phraya Delta. With exotic flavours of lemongrass and watermelon, this is a light-bodied wine with a crisp and fresh finish. IMPORTED THAI RED WINE Monsoon Valley (Siam Winery) <i>This wine is made from a blend of the local Pok Dum, Shiraz & Black Muscat grapes grown on the amazing "floating vineyards" north of the gulf of Thailand in the Chao Phraya Delta. With bright and clean red fruit aromas, this is a medium-bodied wine with a velvety finish. White Wines



5. CHARDONNAY **12.45**
 McGregor Columbard Chardonnay
 (South Africa) *Well-Balanced white, showing a crisp palate of ripe tropical fruits off set by leaner, greener columbard.*

6. CHARDONNAY Los Espinos **14.25**
 (Chile). *Fresh vibrant and mouth watering with tangy citrus and tropical fruit overlaid with buttery, nutty nuances.*



7. CHENIN BLANC Pulpit Rock **14.60**
 (South Africa) *Situated in the Swartland region of the Cape where the warmer climate produces rich flavoursome whites and powerful reds. This gorgeously ripe, tangy chenin is crisp yet full with ripe apple and honey character coupled with a lovely creamy finish.*

White Wines



- 8. CHENIN BLANC, Aloe tree 15.50**
 (South Africa) *A delightfully crisp, fruit driven white with hints of green apple and pear on the nose. Bright, juicy fruit on the palate with a tangy, refreshing finish.*

- 9. SAUVIGNON BLANC 17.50**
 (Chile) Botalcura, El Delirio *An elegant, crisp example with fresh citrus notes accompanied by a beautifully textured palate and long finish.*



- 10. SAUVIGNON BLANC 24.89**
 Sherwood Estate
 (New Zealand) *New Zealand provides us with the worlds most characteristic flavours. Ripe, tropical fruit mingles with racy, gooseberry and asparagus hints.*

- 11. RIESLING DRY, Lalla Gully 22.75**
 (Tasmania) *This is a racy, vibrant Riesling from Tasmania. Crisp, dry and aromatic on the nose with lovely limey, elderflower character coupled with touches of grapefruit. Good intensity of flavour with hints of mineral.*



- 12. PINOT GRIGIO 19.70**
 (Italy) Villa Brunasca *A wonderfully crisp, Zesty example of a wine that all too often is just plain dull! Full of citrusy fruit with hints of almond, this is a youthful refreshing style.*

- 13. PINOT GRIGIO 15.25**
 (Italy) Terra Dacica, Romania. *This classic Italian variety offers an easy drinking style with crisp citrusy fruit and a refreshing finish..*



- 14. SANCERRE, Le Clos de Chaudenay 27.00**
 (France) Domaine Daulny *An intense, concentrated Sauvignon that displays crisp, smoky citrus fruit overlaid with hints of honey and mineral. Well balanced and long, this is an exciting example of a wine that all too often disappoints.*

- 15. CHABLIS, Denis Race 26.97**
 (France) *Pale yellow colour with green tinges, good fruit and acidity on the nose with a well balanced buttery Chardonnay fruit and citrus acidity. Finishing long and fresh on the palate.*



Sparkling Wines & Champagnes



- 16. MIRET Cava Brut Reserva** **19.75**
 (France) *Enticing fruit filled and frothy, this is an attractive fizz for any occasion.*

- 17. CHAMPAGNE PIERRE MIGNON** **42.00**
 Grand Reserve. *A crisp, well balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.*



- 18. POMMERY Brut Royal** **49.29**
Pommery makes Champagnes that are fresh, elegant and lively. Bottle age adds complexity and great winemaking adds style. refreshing and palate stimulating.

Rose Wines

- 19. ROSE Giné Giné Rosado** **24.00**
 BUIL & GINÉ

(Spain) *One of the most exciting Rose "finds" of the year, this blend of Grenache and Merlot offers up an enticing deep salmon pink colour combined with vibrant, juicy yet savoury red fruit on the nose. Rich, vinous and inviting on the palate with a huge array of ripe wild fruits.*



Red Wines



- 20. PINORD CRIANZA Clos de Torribas** **16.50**
 (Spain) *Penedes Silky, wild strawberry fruit character and a warming mellow, warming, typically Spanish mouthful.*

- 21. TERRANOLO PRIMITIVO Apollonio** **19.74**
 (Italy) *Depending on who you talk to, the Primitivo grape is either the same or very similar to California's Zinfandel. Either way it provides an exhilarating array of flavours dominated by wild brambly fruit, sweet oak flavours and an almost balsamic savouriness.*



- 22. SHIRAZ, Largesse** **14.25**
 (France) *A generous taste of Southern France. Warm, rich and spicy. Seductively succulent and deliciously mellow.*

- 23. SHIRAZ, Blewitt Springs** **24.84**
 (Australia) *Mclaren Vale; Peppery characters, and soft Shiraz flavours are excellent features, further developed with careful oak maturation in French and American casks.*



Red Wines

24. PINOT NOIR Yarra Valley **27.50**
 (Australia) Shelmerdine Vineyards *Low yields resulted in concentrated fully ripe grapes which offer up flavours of ripe cherry and strawberry combining with subtle notes of cloves and spice. The restrained French oak add some toasty, savoury complexity as well as hints of coffee and mocha. The finish is lifted and pure with wild strawberry notes and a warm, velvety texture.*



25. MERLOT **17.50**
 (Chile) Botalcura; El Delirio Merlot *Chile's reputation for Merlot has sometimes clouded the fact that it was often Carmener! This is no pretender though - it's a full on ripe, soft fleshy merlot with bags of blackberry fruit, well integrated wood and nice texture.*

26. MALBEC RESERVA, Santa Rosa **19.74**
 (Argentina) Familia Zuccardi *A rich, muscular red with deep, ripe dark fruits. Huge concentration on the palate with succulent berry fruit and hints of tobacco, vanilla and spice from the oak. The finish is powerful though beautifully textured and complex*



27. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Majella **30.00**
 (Australia) *Few regions of Australia command the respect that Coonawarra does and few growers within that region are as highly regarded as Majella. A long term high quality grower, the Lynn family started bottling under their own label in the early '90's. Since then they have rightly been regarded as the best producer in the region with every wine rated 5 stars by the revered Aussie wine writer, James Halliday. This wine is full, elegant, rich and succulent with complex cassis, mulberry and mocha notes. An absolute stunner.*

28. CHATAUNEUF DU PAPE **34.00**
 Les Combes D'Arnevels
 (France) Vignobles Jerome Quiot, *Classic, medium bodied Chateaufneuf with a richly textured palate of spicy violet and cherry fruit overlaid with a little supple oak aging.*



29. SAUVIGNON/SEMILLON,

Suckfizzle

41.50

(Australia) *A cult wine back in Oz, this is the finest example of its type! Replicating the finest white Bordeaux wines, the Sauvignon and Semillon are barrel fermented to give an intriguing mix of fresh, vibrant, citrus flavours intermingled with the rich, creamy nutty flavours from the oak. Stunning food wine on strict allocation in the U.K.*



30. SANCERRE BLANC,

Le Chêne Marchaud

(France) *Domaine Crochet A complex, concentrated example of Sancerre with well balanced, crisp gooseberry and blackcurrant fruit overlaid with hints of honey and mineral. The finish is elegant and long with tinges of flint and ripe apple.*

31. SHIRAZ,

Mclaren Vale, Angels Share

(Australia) *Recently voted as top Australian Shiraz, Angels Share is made by the incredibly successful two hands winery. Brilliantly opulent fruit with juicy brambles and blackcurrant notes followed by rich creamy palate and long succulent finish. A real stunner!*



32. NUITTS ST GEORGES

41.50

(France) *Domaine Jean Chauvenet; Well structured wine with robust violet and cherry scented fruit coupled with firm elegant tannins and a long good finish.*



33. LALANDE DE POMEROL

42.05

(France) *Chateau de Garraud; A rich, plummy red made from predominantly Merlot grapes. Soft velvety tannins and well balanced, fleshy fruit are complimented by well integrated oak influence.*
